

## **SEARCH FOR 150 OUTSTANDING VINCENTIAN ALUMNI**

Universidad de Sta. Isabel (USI), with the USI Alumni Association (USIAA) is giving recognition to Outstanding Vincentian Alumni who exemplify the Vincentian values in their respective fields of expertise, competence in pioneering human endeavors, commitment to their professions and compassion for others, particularly the marginalized in society.

Four types of award are to be conferred on the occasion of the Universidad's 150<sup>th</sup> founding anniversary on April 12, 2018.

- The Outstanding Vincentian Alumni Award
- Vincentian Family Award
- Young Vincentian Achiever
- Meritorious Achievement Award

### **I. GENERAL CRITERIAL FOR THE AWARDS**

1. An Alumnus/Alumna of USI

The individual must have completed his/her primary or secondary or tertiary or graduate education in the Universidad de Sta. Isabel.

2. Outstanding achievement and exceptional contributions to his/her field, industry or specialization\*
3. Peer recognition in field of expertise
4. Exemplary moral and Christian conduct
5. Loyalty to USI

\*An Alumna/Alumnus may be nominated to only one (1) particular field/industry/specialization. The may only be one (1) awardee in a given field/industry/specialization.

6. Significant contribution to the USI for the achievement of its Vision-Mission.

## II. ADDITIONAL CRITERIA

### A. Young Achievers Award

The individual must not be more than thirty-five (35) years old.

- **Vincentian Family Award**

The Award is conferred upon a family whose members are all Alumni of the Universidad de Sta. Isabel and who meet the general criteria.

- **Meritorious Achievement Award**

An individual who was educated at USI, for at least two (2) years, but did not complete his/her primary, secondary or tertiary education from the Universidad due to varying reasons is an Associate-Alumnus/Alumna. He /she may be conferred a Meritorious Achievement Award based on the general criteria.

#### **IV. NOMINATION PROCESS**

##### **A. Who may nominate**

1. USI Administrator, Faculty members, Support Staff and Students
2. Alumni Batches
3. Recipients of Alumni awards
4. Accredited Professional Organizations
5. Reputable National /International Organizations
6. Church/Religious organizations

##### **B. Guidelines to follow**

1. Nomination should be made using the prescribed Award Nomination Form available at the USI President's Office. Forms may likewise be downloaded via USI/Alumni website.

2. The Nominator must submit an original copy of the Nomination Portfolio and an electronic or digital version which contain the following:
  - a. Duly accomplished Nomination Form;
  - b. Nominee's curriculum vitae, with his/her most recent 2x2 photo;
  - c. Written acceptance of the candidate of his/her nomination
  - d. Executive Summary of the Nominee's achievements, not less than three (3) pages with encoded text using font (Times New Roman) size 12 on a legal sized bond paper, should not exceed twenty (20) pages.
  - e. Artworks (Painting, Sculpture, etc.) may be photographed and included in the candidate's portfolio, if applicable.
  - f. The Nomination Portfolio (using expandable envelope), containing the above-mentioned documents, should be submitted to:
