

Project Angat Bahay (started Feb. 2017)

This project intends to uplift the dignity of the beneficiaries (indigent families) by providing them the basic skeletal structures of a concrete house and inspire families to dream for better dwellings and for them improve their houses slowly on their own. Construction materials are provided by donors from the university (student organizations, members of the faculty, from different units of the school, from the sisters, a few funded by the school ICESA fund, and a few funded by an outside organization.



To date there are 24 houses already constructed. Other than a single paid skilled carpenter, all the structures were built by volunteers from the community (bayanihan) and from the university (teachers, students and non-teaching staff including sisters). Angat Bahay project is a continuing project and targets at least 100 units until 2024. To date 24 units have already been constructed, 21 are already being occupied and improved by the beneficiaries.
