## Who can avail of TES?

The priority beneficiaries for the Tertiary Education Subsidy (TES) are:

- Students who are part of households included in the Listahanan 2.0, ranked according to the estimated per capita household income; and
- students not part of the Listahanan 2.0, ranked according to estimated per capita household income based on submitted documentation of proof of income to be determined by the UniFAST Board;

## CHED TES application

- After you enroll, contact the TES Focal person or the assigned person responsible for the TES program of your school on the process of application in the TES Portal.
- The information of the student will be submitted by the TES Focal Person in the TES Portal.
- Unifast will then have a Nationwide Assessment which includes name matching verification, validation, and ranking.

- The result will be posted on the TES portal of the HEI.
- The school will inform the students if they have been qualified for them to be able to submit the Documentary Requirements.
- Student grantees will pass the needed documents in his/her school.
- The school will then submit the needed Certified Documentary Requirements to CHED Regional Offices.
- After Unifast verification of the documents, the TES grants will be given to the school for the Tes grantees.
- TES grants will then be distributed to the beneficiaries.

### **Documentary Requirements for the TES grantees**

- Certificate of Registration of Enrollment
- Assessment of Fees
- Certificate of Residency
- Photocopy of PWD ID (if applicable)
